



### **Admission Procedure:**

#### **BTech Programmes:**

Admissions to B.Tech Programmes are strictly based on merit through Govt. Quota and Management Quota.

Eligibility for admission to the B.Tech programme, admission policy and procedure shall be decided from time to time by following the guidelines issued by the Government of Kerala and other statutory body such as APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University (KTU), AICTE etc.

50 % Govt. Quota seats and 50% Management Quota seats (including NRI Quota seats) Govt. Quota

1. Govt. Quota seats will be allotted by the Commissioner of Entrance Examinations based on KEAM 2021 Rank
2. College code for Govt. Quota is IGW
3. For Govt. Quota seats, candidates have to apply online with the college code and branch of preference as and when announced by the Commissioner of the Entrance Examination.

**Management Quota:**

1. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala, or Examinations recognized as equivalent thereto, with 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) put together are eligible for Management seats admission. (As per KEAM Prospectus)
2. Candidates must qualify in KEAM 2021.
3. AGE: Applicants should have completed 17 years of age.
4. Nationality: Candidates must be Citizens of India.
5. Candidates can submit applications ONLINE through the link <http://iggis.mnets.in/Student/ApplicationForm?ID=3>
6. Applications should be complete in all respects. A candidate will be considered for admission, only if he/she has furnished the relevant certificates prescribed in the Prospectus, in proof of eligibility.

**M.Tech Programmes:****Govt. Quota:**

50% of the total seats in each of the course are set apart as Govt. quota seats. Candidates interested in Govt. quota seats have to register their names online in the website of Director of Technical Education (DTE) [www.dtekerala.gov.in](http://www.dtekerala.gov.in) as per their notification expected shortly. DTE will prepare a rank list by considering the candidate's Gate score/aggregate marks obtained up to 6th semester in qualifying degree examination. Based on the ranking by DTE, the seats will be filled on inter se merit, observing the Reservation Rules as per G.O (P)208/66/Edn. dated 02-05-1966. G O (MS) 95/08/SCSTDD dated 06-10-2008 and as modified from time to time by the Govt.

**Management Quota:**

The remaining 50% seats are under management Quota. Admission to Management seats is conducted by the Management. Admission is strictly on the basis of merit. Applications are available online. Candidates need to submit only one online application for Govt./Management Quota.

## **Diploma programmes:**

Admissions to Diploma Programmes are strictly based on merit through Govt. Quota and Management Quota.

Govt. Quota:

- 1.The candidate shall be a citizen of India.
2. Candidates seeking admission to Polytechnic Colleges shall be categorized as Keralite and Non Keralite.
3. The candidate shall have passed SSLC/THSLC or equivalent examination, with eligibility for higher studies.

Note: - . Candidates who have passed qualifying examination with Mathematics, English and Science subjects are eligible to apply for both stream I and stream II.

4. A candidate who has taken more than two chances to secure eligibility for higher studies in SSLC/THSLC or equivalent examinations is not eligible for admission.

5. For CBSE/ICSE/Open school candidates the Marks/Grades obtained in Science is considered for calculating grade in the place of Physics and Chemistry. As per the Circular No. Acad 03/2019 dated 10th January 2019 of AICTE, CBSE school candidates who have passed qualifying examination with Mathematics-Standard are only eligible to apply for stream

Management Quota:

The remaining 50% seats are under management Quota. Admission to Management seats is conducted by the Management. Admission is strictly on the basis of merit. Applications are Available online.
